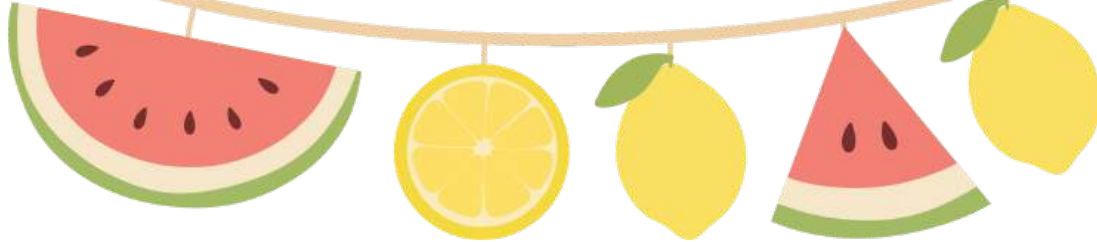

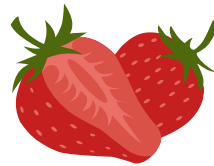

**Strawberries** – sweet, aromatic, rich in vitamin C and antioxidants, e.g., Polish Kashubian strawberries rank second in the world's best fruit rankings.



**Peaches** – juicy, contain vitamins A and C, potassium, and fiber; the first place in the world ranking went to the Rodakina Naoussas variety from Greece.



**Cherries** – an excellent source of antioxidants and vitamin C, in 17th place in the Taste Atlas ranking is the Polish Nadwiślanka cherry.



**Raspberries** – rich in fiber, vitamin C, and anthocyanins; support heart health and brain function.



**Mangoes** – often referred to as the "King of Fruits," mangoes are the quintessential tropical fruit. They are a massive agricultural product in India, Southeast Asia, and Latin America, serving as the base for many beverages, chutneys.



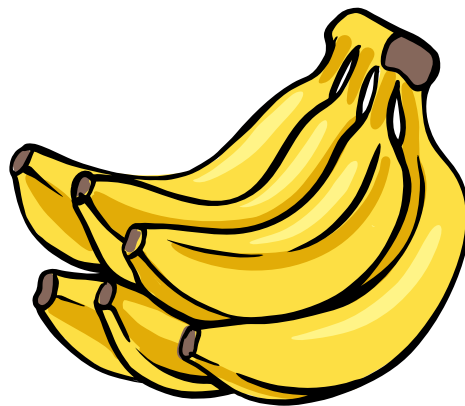
# THE MOST POPULAR FRUITS IN SUMMER

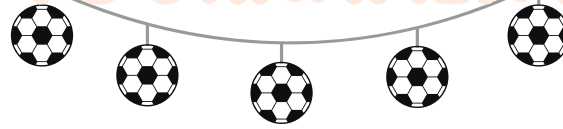
This year took place 70th edition of this competition in Vienna, because one year ago contest won JJ from Austria. The show won Bulgaria and Dara with song “Bangaranga”. This is a pop song with folk and oriental sounds. This winner is a surprise because Bulgaria returned do Eurovision after four years and Dara wasn't the favorite to win the contest.

This year Poland was represented by Alicja Szemplińska and her song “Pray”. We can hear that we got four’s twelves (maximum point) points from jury, first time from 23 years. We finished 7th place in jury voting, but from televotes we got only 17 points and finally we finished on 12th place with 150 points. After “Bangaranga” victory next year contest will take place in Bulgaria.





# SCHOOL FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT


According to the results of our school survey, the is the most popular drink,however teachers prefer coffee.

# AFTER 8TH GRADE EXAM ...TYPES OF SCHOOLS



The most important thing before and after the eighth-grade exams is choosing our **high school**. How to prepare for this decision without getting stressed out? First, you need to know about the three types of schools – general high school, technical high school or vocational school. In general high school we choose profiles. It is very important, because if you like Math and you enjoy it, you can go to profiles with advanced Mathematics and Physics or Geography. But if you don't like Math and you aren't good at it you don't have to choose this profile. If you are interested in nature and science, you can go to class with advanced Biology and Chemistry. The same is with different profiles. High school can be artistic, sports or bilingual school, but you must pass special exams, if you want to attend them. In high school you study for four years and finally you write high school matura exam, after that you can go to studies.

In **technical high school** you have to choose the type of profession you are going to learn at school. We can go to gastronomic, mechanics, electrics and more technical high school. It is ongoing 5 years, and after you have the same exam as in general high school and vocational exams. In this school we can do two professions.


Last school is **vocational school**. If you know your future job that you are interested in, this school is for you. Vocational school has types of vocations, which you can learn. You can study three of them. This school is going on for 3 years and next you can go to this type of school - upper secondary vocational school. After these three years you have to pass vocational exams.

When you select school you should think about distances, level of teaching and your dream profile or vocation. Next you are going through the process of applying for and getting into high school.

## STAR WARS - FUN FACTS

In scenes from the original Star Wars trilogy: Episode VI – Return of the Jedi, the "return" effect of the lightsaber was achieved in a surprisingly simple but extremely demanding way. Instead of using computer CGI — which practically didn't exist at the time — the creators used classic filming tricks. The actor first... threw the lightsaber from his hand as far away from himself as possible. Then the film tape was played backward. This made it look on screen as if the weapon was perfectly returning to the hero's hand using the Force. It sounds simple, but in practice it was very difficult to film. Mark Hamill had to move his hand exactly opposite to natural movement — so that after reversing the footage it looked believable. Appropriate facial expressions were also required. An additional problem was the trajectory of the prop's flight itself. This often required many takes and perfect coordination of the actor with the special effects crew.

Order 66 from Star Wars: Episode III – Revenge of the Sith is one of the most memorable moments of the entire saga. In the film, Chancellor Palpatine issues a secret order to all the Republic clones, commanding them to immediately eliminate the Jedi, who only moments before were their commanders and comrades-in-arms. Over the years, many theories and interpretations have arisen around the number "66." One popular trivia says that it might be a reference to the World War II order concerning the dropping of the atomic bomb on Hiroshima. In reality, however, there are no credible statements from George Lucas or the creators of Star Wars confirming such a reference. Historically, the order to launch an atomic attack on Hiroshima did not officially exist under the name "Order 66."

At first glance, it sounds like a legend of Star Wars fans, but the story contains quite a bit of truth. It concerns the small island of Niue in the South Pacific — one of the smallest countries in the world, inhabited by about 2,000 people. Niue is an associated territory of New Zealand and officially uses the New Zealand dollar. However, the country has been issuing collectible themed coins for years, which formally have the status of legal tender. Among them, there are also coins inspired by the Star Wars universe — featuring characters such as Darth Vader, Yoda, and Luke Skywalker. Technically, this means that they could be used to buy something in Niue, because they have a denomination and the status of official currency. For example, a coin with a denomination of 2 dollars might cost tens or even hundreds of dollars as a collectible item.
